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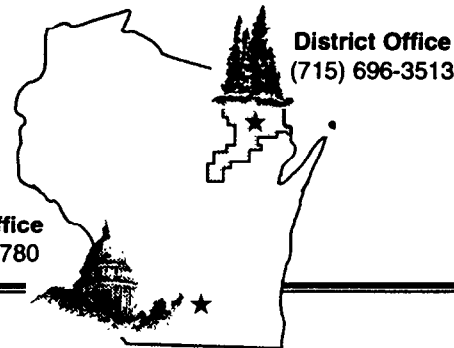

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, in any county with a population of less than 500,000 (Milwaukee County is currently the only county with a population greater than 500,000), the county board may require that deputy sheriff positions be filled by appointment by the sheriff from a list of all persons with the highest scores for each position based on a competitive examination. The examination may be given by a county civil service commission or by the division of merit recruitment and selection in the department of employment relations (DER). If the examination is given by DER, the department must certify to the sheriff a list of eligible names of all persons with the highest scores on the examination for each position.

1           59.26 (8) (a) In any county with a population of less than 500,000, the board,  
2 by ordinance, may fix the number of deputy sheriffs to be appointed in that county

7 examination of persons residing in this state for at least one full year prior to the date



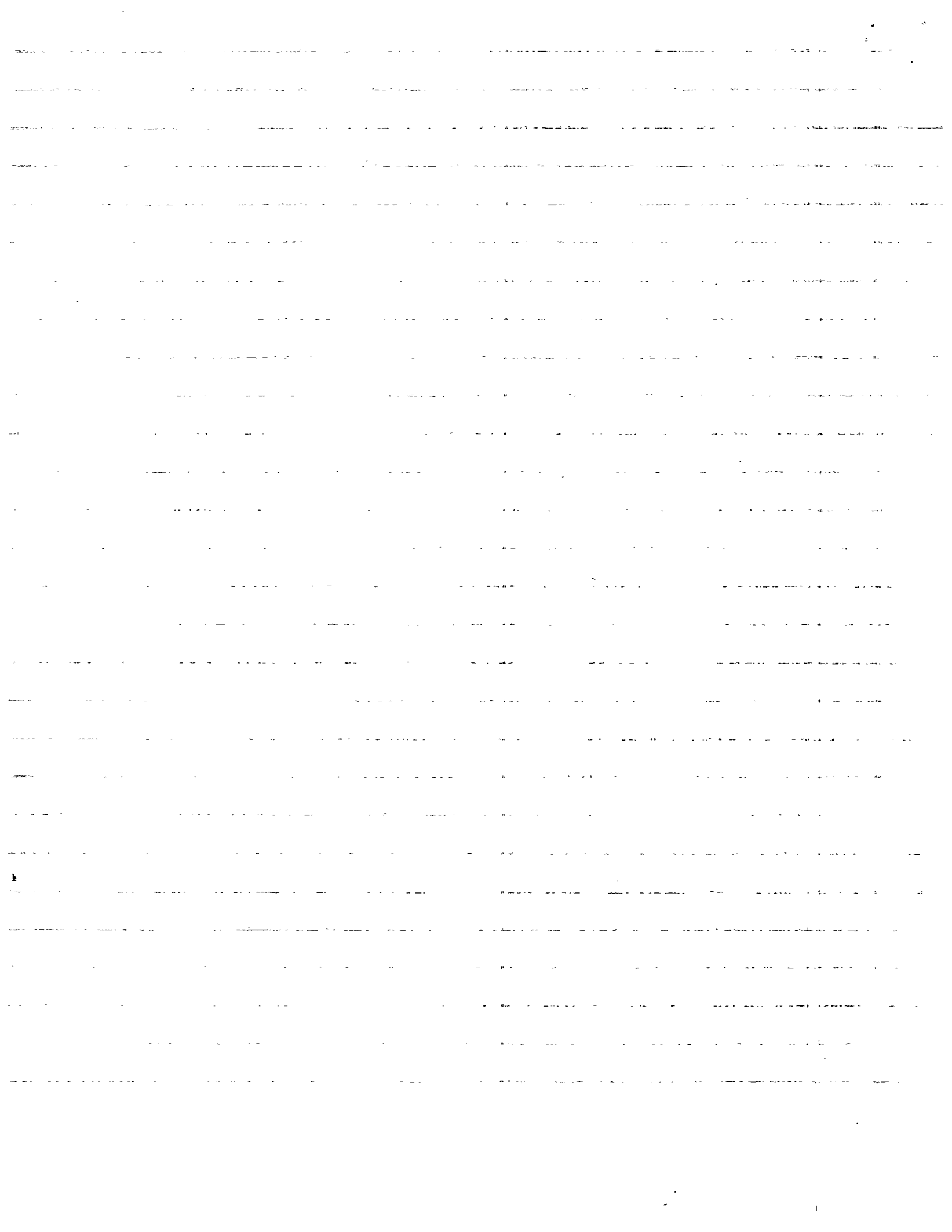

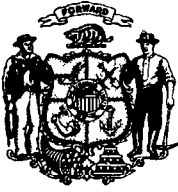
