This bill would amend the Fair Employment Act to prohibit employers from discriminating against an employe who is a "health care provider" and who refuses to engage in certain specified medical procedures. Under the bill, those employes of the State of Wisconsin who allege such discrimination could file a complaint of discrimination with the Personnel Commission. Health care providers in the State alleging such discrimination by an employer other than the State of Wisconsin would file their complaints with the Department of Workforce Development. The Personnel Commission assumes that it would receive 5 to 10 additional complaints per year for investigation and processing as a consequence of the bill. More than 200 complaints and 150 appeals are already filed with the Commission annually. Existing staff will be able to absorb this estimated increase in caseload without additional expenditures.
