Instead of using a cite to "permit issued under s. 95.60 (2)", I used "registered under s. 95.60 (3m)". I think the substituted reference is broader, as it will apply to everything covered by 95.60 (2), plus those fish farms that do not use imported fish or eggs.

I did not use a reference to s. 29.733 (2), since it seemed that any permitted body of water under that section would also be registered under s. 95.60 (3m).

The substitute amendment is identical to the bill, but adds the condition of being registered. Please let me know if these changes will meet your intent.





Representative Skindrud:

No person may operate a fish farm in this state without registering with DATCP under s. 95.60 (3m). Fish farms using a natural body of water need a permit from DNR issued under s. 29.733, but still must register with DATCP. It is not necessary to specify both DATCP-registered and DNR-permitted, since every DNR-permitted fish farm must be DATCP-registered. This substitute amendment covers all fish farms, including those using natural bodies of water.
