Instead of using a cite to "permit issued under s. 95.60 (2)", I used "registered under s. 95.60 (3m)". I think the substituted reference is broader, as it will apply to everything covered by 95.60 (2), plus those fish farms that do not use imported fish or eggs.

I did not use a reference to s. 29.733 (2), since it seemed that any permitted body of water under that section would also be registered under s. 95.60 (3m).

The substitute amendment is identical to the bill, but adds the condition of being registered. Please let me know if these changes will meet your intent.


