receive the aid. To ensure compliance with this federal law, the federal government runs a cross check with the Selective Service. When a student has applied for federal aid without registering for Selective Service,					
the federal processor notifies HEAB.					
Since Selective Service registration is not currently required in order to receive Wisconsin financial					
assistance, this data is currently not being loaded on to our student record system. It would require computer programming time in order for this information to be brought in to our state record system from the					
federal data file.
