Dear Representative Huebsch:

A review of the draft of this bill raises a question with regard to page 53 of the draft. In Sections 138 and 139, there is reference to proposed changes in Section 767.081 of the statutes. That section of the statutes presently requires that the Family Court Commissioner provide statutory and procedural information to litigants.

It is our belief that, almost universally throughout the state, that requirement is now being met by the Family Court Commissioner's Office in each county. That is where the materials are made available and procedural help is being given.

The proposed bill, in these sections, uses the beginning language, "A circuit court commissioner shall....." which seems to imply that <u>any</u> circuit court commissioner can be asked, and must provide, this information. This, especially in larger counties such as Milwaukee, could have unintended results and complicate procedures now in place in many counties to centralize procedural information sources.

We would suggest that the words "a circuit court commissioner" in both sections be changed to one of the following phrases:

The Office of Family Court Commissioner shall....

OR

--- The <u>circuit court commissioner appointed to supervise the Office of Family Court Commissioner shall....</u>

We believe this will make this revision more clear and will also insure that the function to provide such information remains a focus in the office where we believe the legislature intended it to be.

We respectfully request that your committee consider this point when it discusses this bill.
