In consultation with the DOA and DOR, the commission shall study the establishment of a program for providing incentives for the siting, development, maintenance and reconstruction of production plants and general structures as defined in 79.04, including incentives to the municipalities and counties wherein these plants or structures are or will be located. This study shall include those production plants or general structures that are owned by public utilities, as defined in 196.01(5), cooperative associations organized under Chapter 185, a qualified wholesale electric company as defined in 76.28(gm) and a municipal utility that is owned wholly by a municipality and that owns a retail electric distribution system.

No later than January 1, 2001, the commission shall submit a report of its findings and recommendations under par(a) to the chief clerk of each house of the legislature for distribution to the appropriate standing committee under 13.172(3).

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
