This bill prohibits the sale and offering for sale in this state of containers of malt liquor that contain more than a quart of that be rage. A person who violates that prohibition is liable for a forfeiture of not more than \$500 for a first offense, for a forfeiture of not more than \$1,000 for a Mil offense and is subject to having the HARAGE license to sell alcohol beverages revoked or suspended for a BAH offense.
