This legislation authorizes counties, cities, villages and towns to enact ordinances to regulate campaign finance activity at the local level. The State Elections Board will incur staff costs to develop administrative rules to certify that local ordinances conform to state law. There will also be extensive review of the proposed ordinances to determine compliance. It is assumed that local government will consult with Elections Board staff in the development of the local ordinances. Local governments will need to establish local boards to administer and enforce the new ordinances. Local governments will be adding to the workload of existing personnel to administer and enforce the ordinances. Under current law local government notifies registrants of filling requirements, receives reports, then makes them available for public inspection and refers enforcement matters (primarily for late or nonfilling) to the district attorney.
