

1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 417

1 **AN ACT to create** 13.94 (1) (p), 15.04 (1) (n) and 16.547 of the statutes; **relating**
2 **to:** requiring state departments and independent agencies to monitor federal
3 programs and identify goals for state capture of federal resources under those
4 programs.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

PREFATORY NOTE: This bill was prepared for the joint legislative council's special committee on capture of federal resources.

Current law sets forth a number of duties for heads of all state departments and independent agencies. This bill adds a requirement that the head of each department and independent agency monitor the creation and reauthorization of federal programs within the department's or independent agency's jurisdiction, identify defensible dollar and percentage goals for Wisconsin's share of federal resources under those programs and make concerted efforts to reach those goals. The bill also requires that the head of each department and independent agency submit a written report on his or her activities in this regard to the department of administration by September 30 of each even-numbered year.
