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



Worker, Clinical Marriage and Family Therapist and Clinical Professional

Counselors:

The request is for a new AB 517 for 1999-00. The request is not the same as the request for AB 517.

1. We **are not including** the Bachelorate **Social Workers**, the Advanced Social Workers, School Social Workers, of School Counselors.

- 2. This is a licensure for the practice of clinical psychotherapy. The only people that would be effected would be the independent clinical social worker, the marriage and family therapist and the professional counselor.
- 3. The practice of psychotherapy would include the ability to counsel and administer and interpret tests of mental abilities, aptitudes, interest, attitudes, personality characteristics, emotion and motivation as well as analyzing the results of these test and interviews.
- 4. The minimum requirement to be licensed would be a MA in: a) clinical social work or its equivalent, b) marriage and family therapy or its equivalent, and c) professional counseling or its equivalent. The MA would have to have 60 hrs. of graduate study with clinical field training.
- 5. The applicant would also have engaged in the equivalent of at least 2 years of full-time supervise clinical practice.

- 6. The applicant would have to have training in at least one of the three scopes of practice in psychotherapy, that is clinical social work, clinical marriage and family therapy and clinical professional counseling.

The advanced social worker and independent social worker could be licensed only after they have completed the 2 years of supervised clinical work. The same would hold true or school counselors.

The scope of practice definition for these three practices would be the same as in AB 517V

This request differs from AB 5 17 in that we are not including BA social workers, or advanced and independent social workers. These categories can still receive certification but not licensure.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the use of titles related to social work, marriage and family therapy and professional counseling is restricted to persons who satisfy certain eligibility requirements and who are granted a certificate by the examining board of social workers, marriage and family therapists and professional counselors (examining board). With respect to social work, there are certificates for the following titles: "social worker", "advanced practice social worker", "independent social worker" and "independent clinical social worker". The examining board is required to promulgate rules that specify the services that a person who is granted one of the social work certificates is qualified to perform. Current law does not prohibit a person who has not been granted a certificate from practicing social work, marriage and family therapy or professional counseling.

This bill transforms the certification requirements under current law into licensing requirements and restricts the use of titles related to social work, marriage and family therapy or professional counseling to persons who are licensed. The bill also prohibits, with certain exceptions, a person from practicing social work, marriage and family therapy or professional counseling unless he or she is licensed. In addition, a person may not perform services that may be performed by an advanced practice, independent or independent clinical social worker unless he or she has been granted a social worker license and either an advanced practice, independent or independent clinical social worker license. The examining board is required to promulgate rules that specify the services that may be performed by the different types of social workers. The eligibility requirements for social worker, marriage and family therapist or professional counselor license, or for a license to practice an advanced level of social works under the bill are the same as the requirements for a certificate under current law.

MUnder current law, no social worker, marriage and family therapist or professional counselor certificate is required for a person to use any of the following titles: "pastoral counselor", "investment counselor", "vocational counselor", "career counselor", "alcohol and drug counselor" or "chemical dependency counselor". This bill does not require a person to be licensed to use such a title or to engage in such counseling. Under current law, no certificate is required for a person who has been granted a school social worker or school counselor license by the department of public instruction to use the title "school social worker" or "school counselor". This bill does not require such a person to be licensed to use such a title. The bill's licensing requirements also do not apply to a person who is: 1) lawfully practicing within the scope of a license, permit, registration or certification granted by this state or the federal government; Appracticing social work within the scope of his or her education

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NSERT 3A or training as a student for a backelor's or master's degree in social work, or 3 licensed to practice social work, marriage and family therapy or professional counseling in another state or territory of the United States and who provides a consultation or demonstration with a person who has been granted a license.

Minder current law, the social worker and professional counselor sections of the examining board may grant a social worker or professional counselor training certificate that allows a person to use the title "social worker" or "professional counselor" before meeting certain eligibility requirements for a certificate. This bill allows the social worker and professional counselor sections of the examining board to grant a social worker or professional counselor training permit that is subject to the same requirements as a training certificate under current law. Also under current law, any section of the examining board may grant the following: 1) a temporary certificate to a person who has not yet passed an examination required for a certificate; and 2) a reciprocal certificate to a person who is certified in another state that has substantially similar certification requirements. Under this bill, any section of the examining board may grant a temporary or reciprocal, license that is subject to the same requirements as a temporary or reciprocal certificate under current law





2. Do not incorporate the Colorado law's definition of professional counseling but do change the language for "psychotherapy" on page 6, line 18 thru line 24. Delete line 18 after "means", delete lines 19, 20, and 21 up to the comma ","

After means on line 18 insert "<u>treatment, diagnosis, testing, assessment or counseling in a professional relationship to assist individuals or groups to alleviate mental-and emotional disorders, understand unconscious or conscious motivation, resolve emotional, relationship, or attitudinal conflicts, or modify behavior that interfere with effective emotional, social, or intellectual functioning."</u>

4. Drop any reference to **"60 hrs."** as require for a Master's degree.

#5. Keep the requirement that the applicant must have 2 years of full-time supervised clinical practice and add that "the supervisor must be in the same discipline and must have a PHD or a Master's degree and 5 years of-clinical practice. Also add that those who meet these qualifications may also be supervisors inhospitals and free standing independent mental health clinics. In this latter situation they are not limited to supervising only those in their specific discipline. This refers to the H&FS law governing independent outpatient clinics.

6. The practice is psychotherapy and the license is to practice psychotherapy. Master's degrees in any one of the three scopes of practice or their eauivalent in psychotherapy would make an applicant eligible for licensure provided they have the 2 years of supervised clinical practice.

We would like you to amend the statute further by changing the present board's structure.

First: The board will have two sections, 1) certification section and 2) the licensure section.

The certification section consist of bachelor social workers, advanced social worker and the independent social worker. They will have one representative from each class of social worker but only two votes on the full board. This section will also have one public member. (the public member must belong to an organized consumer group such as AARP, Senior Council, Wisconsin Citizen Action Coalition or similar groups as identified by the Secretary of Regulations and Licensing. This criteria will apply to all public appointees in both sections.

The licensure section will consist of Clinical Social Workers, Marriage and Family Therapist and Professional Counselors. Each class will have 2 representatives for a total of 6 plus 3 public members chosen from organized consumer groups. If other scopes of

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practices qualify for licensure, they can be included under this practice act. Their membership-on-the-Ii&sure section of the board shall be determined by rule. No practice will have less than one representative on the board. The public membership of the whole board will be a total of 4.

The draft also refers to temporary permits for Clinical Social Workers and Professional Counselors. This should also be extended to Marriage and Family Therapist.

This law will eliminate certification for Clinical Social Workers, Marriage and Family Therapist and Professional Counselors. These professions will be licensed as clinical psychotherapist.

The draft should refer to these scopes of practice as Clinical Social Worker, Clinical Marriage and Family Therapist and Clinical Professional Counselors. The word "clinical" indicates that they are a licensed clinical psychotherapist.

Finally all reference to a continuing education requirement should be dropped. There will be no continuing education requirement.

In response to your question to Rep. Urban:

1. Keep the language as you have drafted it. That is the person who has a master's degree is qualified to conduct tests. **However, the test that can be given should be regulated by rule.**

#2. Do not incorporate the Colorado law's definition of professional counseling **but do change the language for "psychotherapy"** on page 6, line 18 thru line 24, delete line 18 after "means" thru line 21 up to the comma","

Insert on line 18 after "means" "the treatment. diagnosis. testing, assessment or counseling in a professional relationship to assist individuals or groups to alleviate mental and emotional disorders. understand unconscious or conscious motivation, resolve emotional, relationshin. or attitudinal conflicts, or modify behavior that interfere with effective emotional, social. or intellectual functioning."

- #3. Independent and Advanced Social Workers should be allowed to practice psychotherapy only under the supervision of an Independent Clinical Social Worker. Page 9 line 21 and 22 would eliminate this practice. It should not. There has to be an exception for the Independent Social Worker & Advance Social Worker to practice psychotherapy under the supervision of a licensed Independent Clinical Social Worker.
- #4. Drop any reference to "60 hrs." as required for a Master's degree.
- #5. Keep the requirement that the applicant must have 2 years fo full-time supervised clinical practice and add that "the supervisor must be in the same discipline and must have a PHD or a Master's degree and 5 years of clinical practice or be a licensed psychiatrist or psychologist. " Also add that those who meet these qualifications may be supervisors in "independent outpatient mental health clinics" It should be clear that the supervision in an outpatient mental health clinic is not limited to their specific discipline. This refers to the H&FS law governing independent outpatient clinics.
- **#6.** The practice is psychotherapy and the license is to practice psychotherapy. A master's degree in any one of the three scopes of practice or their eauivalent in psychotherapy would make an applicant eligible for licensure provided they have the 2 years of supervised clinical practice.

This criteria will apply to all public appointees in both sections.

The licensure section will consist of Independent Clinical Social Workers, Clinical Marriage and Family Therapist and Clinical Professional Counselors. Each class will have 2 representatives for a total of 6 plus 3 public members chosen as above. If other copes of practices qualify for licensure, they must be approve by the legislature. No practice will have less than one representative in this section. The public membership of the whole board will be a total of 4.

The draft also refers to temporary permits for Clinical Social Workers and Professional Counselors. This should also be extended to Marriage and Family Therapist.

This law will eliminate certification for Independent Clinical Social Workers, Marriage and Family Therapist and Professional Counselors. These professions will be licensed as clinical psychotherapist. The title "Clinical" shall be added to their profession where it is absent, i.e. the will be licensed as Clinical Marriage & Family Therapist, Clinical Professional Counselors and Independent Clinical Social Workers.

In that section of the statute which states that this law will not regulate pyschologist, pastoral counselors, etc. you should add "employee assistance counselor".

Finally, there should be no continuing education requirements regulated by the licensure section. Continuing education requires is the task of professional associations.

Changes to my last draft instructions of LRB 081 1/1db

On # 5 of my redraft instructions, the language we would prefer is "the clinical supervision must be conducted by a licensed practitioner in the same discipline of the applicant and must have a PHD, or a Master's degree with 5 years of clinical practice, or the equivalent as determined by rule." We would like to drop the reference to licensed psychiatrist or psychologist. Keep the other language, i.e. "those who meet these qualifications may be supervisors in 'independent outpatient mental health clinics." This latter refers to the regulations of the Dept. of Health and Family Services for independent mental health clinics.

* * As I mention before the licensure is for the practice of psychotherapy as Clinical Social Workers, Clinical Marriage and Family Therapist and Clinical Professional Counselors. We want the word <u>indeuendent</u> dropped from independent clinical social worker. The three professions shall be licensed as <u>Licensed Clinical Social Workers</u>, (LCSW); Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist. (LMFT); & Licensed Professional Counselors. (LPC).

*** It should be clear that each scope of practice in the licensure section will investigate violations, recommendations and compliance in their own scope of practice and make recommendations of action to the section and the board. Each scope of practice will make recommendations or denials to request for waivers to the section and the board.

Finally there should be no reference to regulating continued education in the licensure section of the board.
