## ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 423

1	AN ACT to amend 29.024 (2g) (a) 2. and 29.971 (1) (a); and to create 29.403,
2	29.971 (1) (ag) and 29.971 (1) (ar) of the statutes; relating to: regulating
3	fishing tournaments, granting rule–making authority and providing penalties.
	The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
4	SECTION 1. 29.024 (2g) (a) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:
5	29.024 <b>(2g)</b> (a) 2. Any permit issued under s. <del>29.38, 29.521, 29.525, 29.53 or</del>
6	<del>29.578</del> <u>29.403, 29.537, 29.733, 29.735, 29.736 or 29.871</u> .
7	<b>SECTION 2.</b> 29.403 of the statutes is created to read:
8	<b>29.403 Fishing tournaments. (1)</b> The department shall promulgate rules
9	to establish a program to authorize and regulate fishing tournaments. The rules
10	shall establish the scope and applicability of the program.
11	(2) The department may require a permit under the program to conduct a
12	fishing tournament and may impose terms and conditions that apply to a specific

1	permit. The department may issue a specific permit under terms and conditions that
2	vary from the requirements of the rules promulgated by the department under sub.
3	(1).
4	(3) The rules promulgated by the department under sub. (1) may include any
5	of the following:
6	(a) Rules governing the circumstances under which a waiver for a permit may
7	be granted under s. 29.197.
8	(b) Rules establishing training or educational requirements for persons who
9	seek a permit under sub. (2).
10	(c) Rules for controlling crowding, preventing unsafe conditions or preventing
11	conflicts among the users of the body of water on which fishing tournaments are held
12	or at facilities for public access to those bodies of water, including boat ramps and
13	parking lots.
14	(d) Rules relating to the prevention of the waste of a natural resource.
15	(e) Rules relating to the protection of the bodies of water of this state, fish and
16	other aquatic resources in those bodies of water.
17	(f) Rules specifying the number of fishing tournaments that may be held on a
18	body of water.
19	(g) Rules governing the frequency with which fishing tournaments may be held
20	and the dates on which they may be held.
21	(h) Rules specifying the number of days over which fishing tournaments, or
22	practices for fishing tournaments, may be held.
23	(i) Rules governing the hours during which fishing tournaments may be held.
24	(j) Rules specifying the location of the bodies of water on which fishing
25	tournaments may be held.

(1), allow a participant in a fishing tournament to 14 engage in any activity in which the department would not allow an angler who is not 15 a participant to engage at the same time on the same body of water. 16 (5) (a) The department shall deny an application for a fishing tournament 17 permit or suspend or revoke a fishing tournament permit if the permit applicant or 18 holder does any of the following: 19 1. Makes a material misrepresentation on a permit application. 20 2. Violates this section, a rule promulgated under this section or a term or 21 condition of a permit. 3. Violates this chapter as it relates to fishing in connection with a fishing 22 23 tournament. 24 4. Fails to adequately supervise a fishing tournament.

1	(b) If the department denies a person's application for a fishing tournament
2	permit or if the permit is revoked under par. (a), the department may not issue a
3	fishing tournament permit to that person for a period of 2 years after the denial or
4	revocation.
5	(6) Any person who participates in a fishing tournament shall comply with the
6	terms and conditions imposed by any permit issued for that fishing tournament
7	under sub. (2).
8	<b>SECTION 3.</b> 29.971 (1) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
9	29.971 (1) (a) For the violation of any requirement of this chapter relating to
10	fishing or fish dealing, by a forfeiture of not more than \$1,000 except as provided
11	under pars. <u>(ag), (ar),</u> (b) and (c) and sub. (5m).
12	SECTION 4. 29.971 (1) (ag) of the statutes is created to read:
13	29.971 (1) (ag) For conducting a fishing tournament without a permit as
14	required by the department, by a forfeiture of not less than \$1,000 nor more than
15	\$2,000.
16	<b>SECTION 5.</b> 29.971 (1) (ar) of the statutes is created to read:
17	29.971 (1) (ar) For participating in a fishing tournament and failing to comply
18	with a term or condition imposed by a permit issued for that fishing tournament
19	under s. 29.403, by a forfeiture of not more than \$500.
20	SECTION 6. Nonstatutory provisions.
21	(1) The department of natural resources shall appoint an advisory committee
22	under section 227.13 of the statutes for the purpose of advising the department in
23	promulgating rules under section 29.403 of the statutes, as created by this act. The
24	advisory committee shall include members representing the following groups or
25	interests:

1	(a) Fishing tournament sponsors.
2	(b) The conservation congress.
3	(c) Sport fishing organizations.
4	(d) Users of lakes and streams in this state.
