You have requested a redraft of 1997 AB-960, which proposed a \$18,500 increase in the appropriation for the elections board for the second half of the 1997-99 fiscal biennium to fund 1.5 GPR positions. I previously completed that draft as LRB-1680/1. However, the relating clause of that draft inaccurately stated that the draft makes an appropriation. The draft actually appropriated \$0. Thus, I have prepared the attached draft to clarify this misstatement in the relating clause.

2. For this draft, I have <sup>inserted</sup> made an appropriation but have specified "\$0-" for expenditure in fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01. 3. 
