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At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

1. Page 18, line 18: What line insert:

"Section 12g. 20.433 (1) (c) of the statutes is created to read:

20.433 (1) (c) Child abuse and neglect prevention grants. A sum sufficient equal state to refer to of the total amounts appropriated and estimated to be expended from all sources for the department of corrections for each fiscal year as shown in the schedule under s. 20.005 (3), to be used for grants to organizations under s. 48.982 (4), (6) and (7) and for statewide projects under s. 48.982 (5). (2f) Child abuse and neclect prevention funding. Notwithstanding section 20.002 (1) of the statutes, if the biennial budget act for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, is not enacted on or before June 30, 1999, moneys encumbered or expended from the appropriation accounts under sections 20.433 (1) (c) and 20.435 (3) (b) of the statutes, as amended by this act, may not exceed, for each month beginning July 1, 1999, until enactment of the biennial budget, an amount equal to one—sixth the amount of the money that was authorized to be encumbered and expended from the

appropriation accounts from January 1, 1999, to June 30, 1999.".

"(4f) CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT PREVENTION FUNDING.

The creation of sections 20.433(1)(c) and 20.435(3)(b) of the statutes takes effect on James 1,000. The day after publication of this act or on the 2nd day of after publication of the 1999-2001 beennial budget act, whichever is later."
