4 20.410 (1) (gb) *Drug testing*. All moneys received from probation, extended
5 supervision and parole clients who are required to pay for their drug testing, as
6 prescribed by rule in accordance with s. 301.03 (3) (b), for expenditures related to the
7 drug testing program for probationers, parolees and persons on extended
8 supervision under s. 301.03 (3) (b)."
