- (e) The committee shall study the classification . . . . recommendations concerning all of the following:
  - increasing clarity and precision in the language of the substantive criminal law, and rationalizing the structure of penalties embedded in it;
  - increasing or reducing the number of penalty classes;
  - placing each crime into its appropriate class;
  - eliminating overlap and duplication, within and across classes, to assure that cases of like seriousness are treated alike and cases of different seriousness are treated differently;
  - increasing the clarity and precision of standards for lesser included offenses and multiple prosecutions:
  - addressing unintended side-effects this Act might have on charging practice and plea negotiation:

TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 465





At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 191, line 14: after that line insert:
