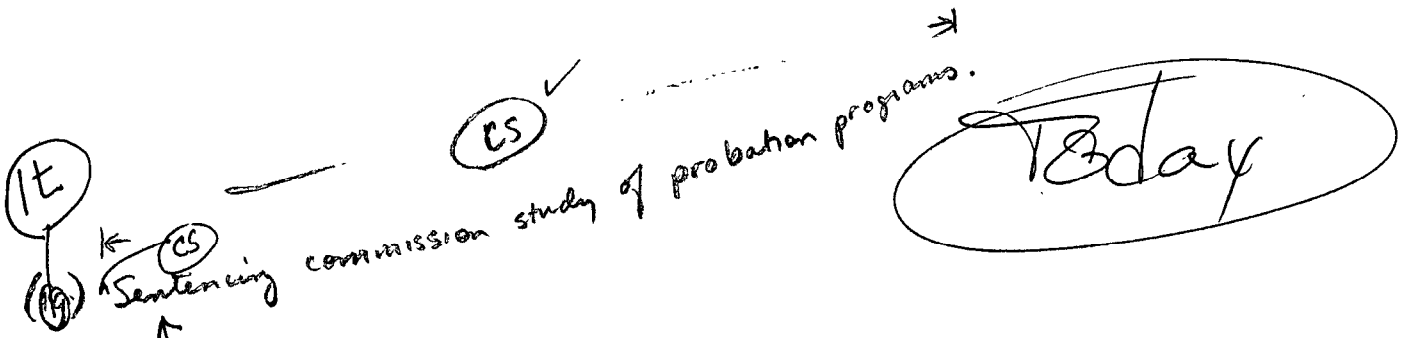

1. Page <sup>193</sup>191, line <sup>18</sup>14: after that line insert:

4 "A) By January 1, 2001, conduct a study and submit recommendations to the  
 5 governor, to each house of the legislature under s<sup>tion</sup> 13.172 (2) <sup>of the statutes</sup> and to the supreme court  
 6 regarding ways to increase the effectiveness of probation, and thereby promote its  
 7 use, as an alternative to imprisonment in Milwaukee, Racine, Kenosha, Ozaukee  
 8 and Waukesha counties."
