1 AN ACT ...; relating to: releasing information from the sex offender registry to
2 certain schools. ✓

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 301.46 (2s) ✓ of the statutes is created to read:

4 301.46 (2s) ✓ RELEASE OF INFORMATION TO PARENTS THROUGH SCHOOL DISTRICT
5 ADMINISTRATORS. (a) In this subsection, ✓ "school district administrator" has the
6 meaning given in s. 115.001 (8). ✓

7 (b) 1. A parent, guardian or legal custodian of a child enrolled in a school district
8 may request the school district administrator to make a request for information
9 under par. (c) ✓ concerning persons subject to bulletin notification under sub. (2m)
10 (am). ✓

11 2. A parent, guardian or legal custodian of a child enrolled in a private school
12 may request the school district administrator of the school district in which the child

1 resides or the school district administrator of the school district in which the private
2 school is located to make a request for information under par. (c) concerning persons
3 subject to bulletin notification under sub. (2m) (am). ✓

4 3. If a parent, guardian or legal custodian of a child intends to move to a new
5 residence that is located in a different school district or intends to enroll his or her
6 child in a private school, the parent, guardian or legal custodian may request the
7 school district administrator of the school district in which the new residence is
8 located or the school district administrator of the school district in which the private
9 school is located to make a request for information under par. (c) ✓ concerning persons
10 subject to bulletin notification under sub. (2m) (am).

11 (c) When a school district administrator receives a request from a parent,
12 guardian or legal custodian under par. (b) ✓ for information concerning persons
13 required to register under s. 301.45, ✓ the school district administrator shall request
14 information concerning the persons from the police chief of the community in which
15 the school district is located or the sheriff of the county in which the school district
16 is located.

17 (d) Upon receiving a request from a school district administrator under par. ✓(c),
18 the police chief or sheriff shall immediately provide in writing all of the following
19 information concerning each person who is residing, employed or attending school
20 in the community or county and about whom the police chief or sheriff has received
21 notification under sub. (2m) (am). ✓

22 1. The person's name, including any aliases used by the person.

23 2. Information sufficient to identify the person, including date of birth, gender,
24 race, height, weight and hair and eye color.

1 3. The statute that the person violated, the date of conviction, adjudication or
2 commitment, and the county or, if the state is not this state, the state in which the
3 person was convicted, adjudicated or committed.

4 4. The address at which the person is residing.

5 5. The name and address of the place at which the person is employed.

6 6. The name and location of any school in which the person is enrolled.

7 7. A description of any motor vehicle that the person owns or that is registered
8 in the person's name, including the information provided by the person under s.
9 301.45 (2) (a) 7. ✓

10 8. The most recent date on which the information under s. 301.45 ✓ was updated.

11 (e) Upon receiving information from a police chief or sheriff under par. ✓ (d), a
12 school district administrator shall in turn provide the information in writing to the
13 parent, guardian or legal custodian who requested the information.

14 (f) 1. A parent, guardian or legal custodian of a child who makes a request for
15 information under par. (b) may also make a request for information under sub. ✓ (5)
16 concerning a person required to register under s. 301.45.

17 2. A public or private elementary or secondary school administrator who makes
18 a request for information under par. (c) ✓ may also make a request for information
19 under sub. (4) ✓ for information concerning persons registered under s. 301.45.

20 **SECTION 2.** 301.46 (5) (a) (intro.) ✓ of the statutes is amended to read:

21 301.46 (5) (a) (intro.) The department or a police chief or sheriff may provide
22 the information specified in par. (b) concerning a specific person required to register
23 under s. 301.45 to a person who is not provided notice or access under ~~sub.~~ sub. (2)
24 ~~to, (2m), (3) or~~ ✓ (4) if, in the opinion of the department or the police chief or sheriff,

1 providing the information is necessary to protect the public and if the person
2 requesting the information does all of the following:

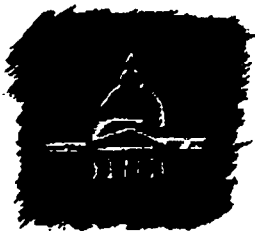


