2	1. Page 3, line 4: delete that line and substitute:
3	"(3) Any person who observes a violation of s. 346.67 to 346.69 may prepare a
4	written report indicating that a violation has occurred. If possible, the report shal
5	contain the following information:

- (a) The time and the approximate location at which the violation occurred.
- (b) The license number and color of the motor vehicle involved in the violation.
- (c) Identification of the motor vehicle as an automobile, station wagon, motor truck, motor bus, motorcycle or other type of vehicle.
- (d) A description of the accident, including a description of the person, vehicle or property that was struck.
- (3m) (a) Within 24 hours after observing the violation, a person may deliver a report prepared under sub. (3) to a traffic officer of the county or municipality in

- which the violation occurred. A report that does not contain all of the information in sub. (3) shall nevertheless be maintained by the county or municipality for statistical purposes.
- 4 (am) Within 48 hours after receiving a report containing all of the information in sub. (3), the traffic officer shall".

- **3.** Page 3, line 7: delete "it" and substitute "the citation".
- **4.** Page 3, line 9: delete "(a)" and substitute "(am)".
