**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate:**

This bill requires school boards to make available to their pupils' parents or guardians all instructional material that will be used in connection with any survey, analysis or evaluation of pupils. The bill also prohibits any official, employee or agent of a school board from conducting any survey, analysis or evaluation of pupils that may reveal information with respect to a pupil or the pupil's family about political affiliations, mental or psychological problems, sexual behavior or attitudes, illegal or antisocial behavior, critical appraisals of family members, privileged relationships, income or religious beliefs or practices, without the pupil's written consent if he or she is an adult or without the written consent of the pupil's parent or guardian. The bill further directs each school board to notify annually the parents enrolled in the school district and their parents or guardians of the above provisions. The bill provides a forfeiture for those school board officers, employees or agents who require pupils to participate in a survey, analysis or evaluation that may reveal the information specified above without the required consent, and provides an enforcement mechanism.

Costs to local districts as a result of this bill are related to the time that staff will devote to obtaining and documenting written consent for administering surveys, analyses and evaluations. While these costs are indeterminable, it is possible that each local district may be able to absorb them in its annual budget. Other costs are related to forfeitures by school board officers, employees or agents who do not obtain the required consent of parents or guardians. These costs are also indeterminable.

There is no state fiscal effect as a result of this bill.
