be used in connection with any survey, analysis or evaluation of pupils. The bill also prohibits any official, emp	
or agent of a school board from conducting any survey, analysis or evaluation of pupils that may reveal inform	ation
with respect to a pupil or the pupil's family about political affiliations, mental or psychological problems, sexual	
behavior or attitudes, illegal or antisocial behavior, critical appraisals of family members, privileged relationship	
income or religious beliefs or practices, without the pupil's written consent if he or she is an adult or without the consent of the pupil's parent or guardian. The bill further directs each school board to notify annually the parei	
enrolled in the school district and their parents or guardians of the above provisions. The bill provides a forfeit	ure for
those school board officers, employees or agents who require pupils to participate in a survey, analysis or evaluation	
that may reveal the information specified above without the required consent, and provides an enforcement	
mechanism.
