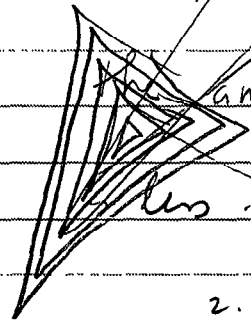

School board mails a schedule of examinations to the pupil's parent or guardian at the beginning of each school year and obtains the written consent of the pupil's parent or guardian for a specific examination. The school board may conduct an additional examination if it mails the pupil's parent or guardian a revised schedule and obtains the written consent of the pupil's parent or guardian to conduct the additional examination.

Annually by September 1, a school board that wishes to examine a pupil under par. (a) shall mail the pupil's parent or guardian a schedule of the number, nature and dates of the examinations that the school board plans to conduct during the school year. The school board may not conduct any examination for which the pupil's parent or guardian have not consented in writing. The school board may conduct an examination in addition to those on the schedule if the school board mails the pupil's parent or guardian a revised schedule and obtains the written consent of the pupil's parent or guardian to conduct the examination.
