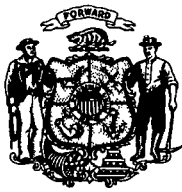

Currently, no sign that is visible from an interstate highway, state trunk highway or U.S. highway may advertise a motorist service offering "FOOD" unless the service has regular operation at least 5 days a week and opens for service no later than 10 a.m. and remains open until at least 7 p.m. Any sign for a "LODGING" or "CAMPING" motorist service that is operated on a seasonal basis must be removed or covered during off seasons.

3           per year, opening for service no later than 10 a.m. and remaining open until at least  
4           7 p.m.;

The bill requires the sign for that service to be covered during the off-season.



3. Obtain **FISCAL ESTIMATE NOW**, prior to introduction \_\_\_\_\_.

If the analysis indicates that a fiscal estimate is required because the proposal makes an appropriation or increases or decreases existing appropriations or state or general local government fiscal liability or revenues, you have the option to request the fiscal estimate prior to introduction. If you choose to introduce the proposal without the fiscal estimate, the fiscal estimate will be requested automatically upon introduction. It takes about 10 days to obtain a fiscal estimate. Requesting the fiscal estimate prior to introduction retains your flexibility for possible redrafting of the proposal.
