

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate:

The bill eliminates the requirement that the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) obtain the social security number for any person applying for hunting or fishing licenses or for certain commercial licenses. Under current law, DNR (and other licensing agencies) request certification from the Department of Revenue on whether license applicants or recipients are liable for delinquent taxes and if they are, DNR denies or revokes their licenses. Eliminating the requirement that DNR obtain social security numbers from license applicants would reduce the effectiveness of this tax compliance tool, but the resulting revenue loss is not expected to be significant.
