This bill allows employes of an employer employing at least 50 individuals to take no more than 16 hours of school conference and activities leave in a 12-month period. This bill will have the most effect on the Department's institutions and centers, which operate for 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. If an individual took time off during a shift, it might be necessary to schedule other workers to cover for this time and thus there would be additional overtime costs. However, it is not known how many individuals would take advantage of the provisions of this bill to take time off for school activities nor the amount of time that would be lost. (Currently, some institutions do not backfill for workers who take less than three or four hours off.) It is, therefore, not possible to estimate the cost to the state as the result of this bill.
