Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, members of authorized special groups may obtain special distinguishing registration plates for certain vehicles registered with the department of transportation (DOT). Special plates may be obtained for automobiles, station wagons, motor homes and certain dual purpose motor homes, farm trucks and dual purpose farm trucks owned or leased by special group members. A fee, in addition to the annual registration fee for the particular kind of vehicle, is assessed for the special plates. Currently, there are authorized special groups associated with veterans of the following wars: World War I, World War II, the Korean War and the Vietnam War.

This bill provides for the issuance of special distinguishing registration plates to veterans of the Laos War in Southeast Asia. A fee of \$10, in addition to the annual vehicle registration fee, is assessed by DOT for issuance or reissuance of the special plates.

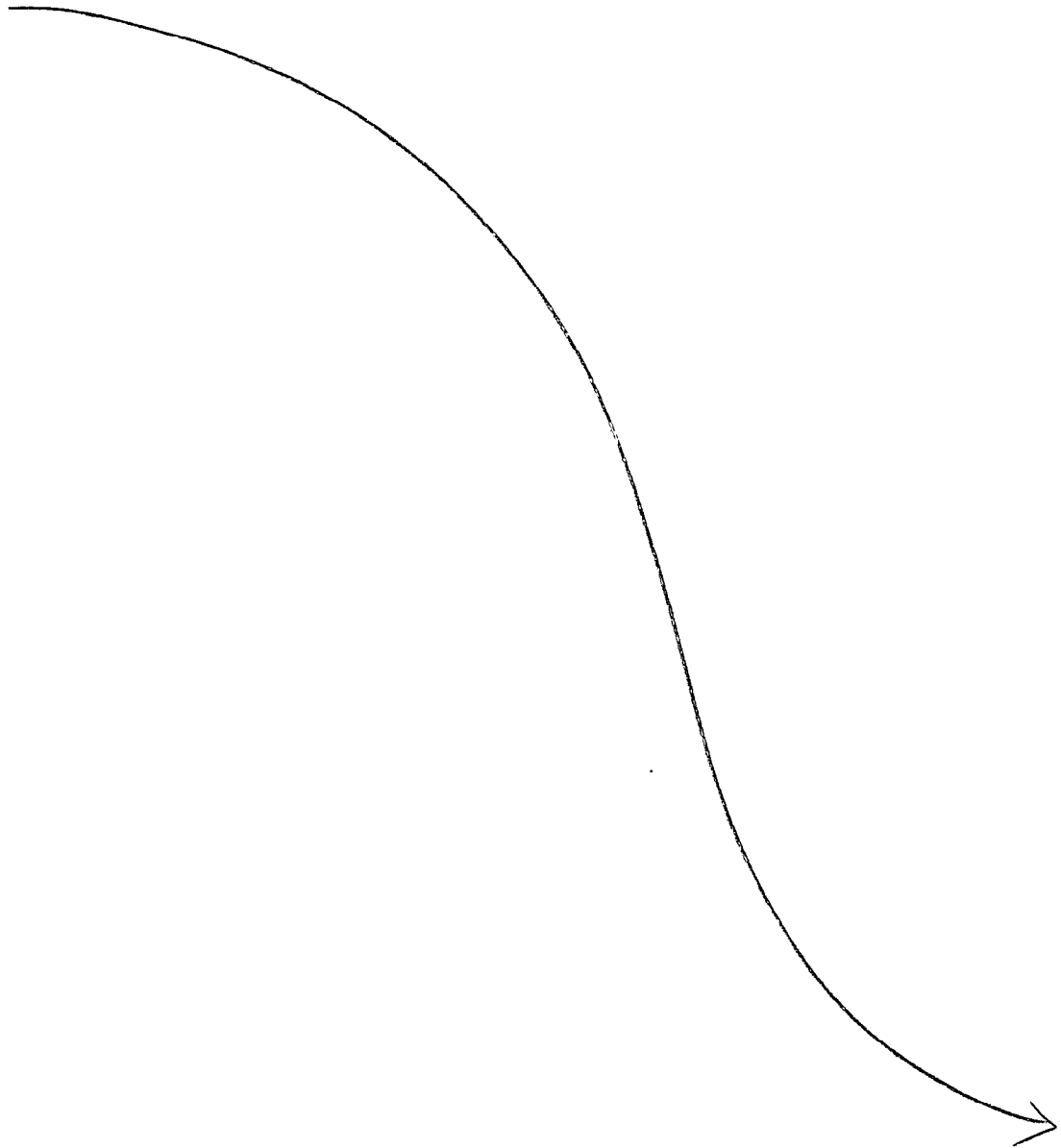




