- 1 AN ACT *to amend* 118.01 (2) (c) 6. of the statutes; **relating to:** requiring school
- 2 boards to provide instruction in the Great Hunger in Ireland, the Armenian
- 3 Genocide and the Holocaust.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law requires school boards to provide instruction in state, national and world history. This bill requires this instruction to include instruction in the Great Hunger in Ireland, the Armenian Genocide and the Holocaust.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 118.01 (2) (c) 6. of the statutes is amended to read:
- 5 118.01 (2) (c) 6. Knowledge of state, national and world history, including
- 6 knowledge of the Great Hunger in Ireland from 1845–50, the Armenian Genocide
- 7 <u>from 1915–23 and the Holocaust of 1933–45.</u>
- 8 Section 2. Effective date.
