This bill requires that every school board's instructional program in state, national and world history include instruction on the Great Hunger in Ireland, from 1845-50, the Armenian Genocide from 1915-23 and the Holocaust of 1933-45.

School districts may incur costs to change their history curricula to include instruction on these historical events. It is assumed that these costs would be small and could be absorbed by the school districts.
