Rep. Steinbrink would like to have an amendment drafted to Assembly Bill 532 that would eliminate the reference to CASA volunteers right to communicate with the jury (Located on page 10, lines 12-15 of the bill)

In addition, he would like the amendment to eliminate the coverage of juveniles (JIPS) under the bill.

He would like to have these two components drafted as a single amendment, with a second request below:

Lastly, on the second amendment request, he would like, if possible, to have an amendment drafted that would set the bill's components as the default governance of the rights and responsibilities of **CASAs**, but allow the specifics to be modified -- made either stronger or weaker -- by the court in the Memorandum of Understanding establishing the CASA relationship.
