

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 7,  
TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 533**

November 10, 1999 – Offered by Representatives HUBER and ZIEGELBAUER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 26, line 8: delete lines 8 to 12 and substitute:

3 **“(2) DUTIES.** The district attorneys of the counties for which additional  
4 assistant district attorney positions are authorized under 1999 Wisconsin Act ....  
5 (this act), sections 24 (1) and 27 (2d), shall each assign the assistant district attorneys  
6 hired for those positions in his or her prosecutorial unit to perform restorative justice  
7 duties. An assistant district attorney assigned under this subsection to perform  
8 justice duties shall do all the following:”.

9 **2.** Page 27, line 10: after “Dane” insert “, Manitowoc, Marathon, Winnebago”.

10 **3.** Page 27, line 16: after “Dane” insert “, Manitowoc, Marathon, Winnebago”.

11 **4.** Page 28, line 17: after “Dane” insert “, Manitowoc, Marathon, Winnebago”.

12 **5.** Page 29, line 13: after “Dane” insert “, Manitowoc, Marathon, Winnebago”.

13 **6.** Page 30, line 10: after that line insert:

1           “(2d) OTHER RESTORATIVE JUSTICE ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEY POSITIONS. In the  
2 schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the  
3 department of administration under section 20.475 (1) (d) of the statutes, as affected  
4 by the acts of 1999, the dollar amount is increased by \$276,600 for fiscal year 1999–00  
5 and the dollar amount is increased by \$553,200 for fiscal year 2000–01 to increase  
6 the authorized FTE positions for the department of administration by 11.5 GPR  
7 positions on January 1, 2000, for assistant restorative justice district attorney  
8 positions as follows: 1.5 positions for Dane County; 1.0 position for Manitowoc  
9 County; 1.0 position for Marathon County; 6.75 positions for Milwaukee County; and  
10 1.25 positions for Winnebago County.”.
