1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 1. Page 2, line 4: after that line insert:

3 "SECTION 1m. 947.0125 (2m) of the statutes, as created by 1999 Wisconsin Act
4 (this act), is amended to read:

5 947.0125 (2m) Whoever violates sub. (2) is guilty of a Class ~~E~~ I felony if the
6 person that the actor intends to frighten, intimidate, threaten, abuse or harass is a
7 person who has not attained the age of 18."

8 2. Page 3, line 7: after that line insert:

9 "SECTION 2m. 948.115 (2) of the statutes, as created by 1999 Wisconsin Act
10 (this act), is amended to read:

11 948.115 (2) Whoever transmits personal information about an individual,
12 knowing that the individual has not attained the age of 16 years, with the intent to

1 induce or encourage a person to violate s. 948.02, 948.05, 948.055, 948.07 or 948.08
2 is guilty of a Class ~~E~~ ^I felony.

3 **SECTION 3g. Nonstatutory provisions.**

4 (1r) **RECONCILIATION PROVISION.** The amendment of section ~~947.0125~~ ^{section} 947.0125 (2m) of
5 the statutes, as created by this act, and ~~948.115~~ (2) of the statutes, as created by this
6 act, and **SECTION 4s** (lg), (2h) and (3i) of this act are void unless the treatment, of
7 section 939.50 (1) (i) and (3) (i) of the statutes by 1999 Assembly Bill 465 is enacted
8 into law before July 1, 2000, in exactly the same form as it appears in sections 237
9 and 246 of 1999 Assembly Bill 465, as passed by the assembly.

10 **SECTION 4s. Effective dates.** This act takes effect on the day after publication,
11 except as follows:

12 (lg) If 1999 Assembly Bill 465 has been enacted on or before the day after
13 publication of this ~~act~~ ^{plain} and the day after publication of this ~~act~~ ^{plain} is on or before
14 December 31, 1999, the amendment of sections 947.0125 (2m) and 948.115 (2) of the
15 statutes takes effect on December 31, 1999.

16 (2h) If 1999 Assembly Bill 465 has been enacted on or before the day after
17 publication of this act and the day after publication of this act is after December 31,
18 1999, the amendment of sections 947.0125 (2m) and 948.115 (2) of the statutes takes
19 effect on the day after publication of this act.

20 (3i) If 1999 Assembly Bill 465 is enacted after the day after publication of this
21 act but before July 1, 2000, the amendment of sections 947.0125 (2m) and 948.115
22 (2) ^{of the statutes} takes effect on December 31, 1999, or on the date that the treatment of section
23 939.50 (1) (i) and (3) (i) of the statutes by 1999 Assembly Bill 465 takes effect,
24 whichever is later." ✓
