## SECTION 3g. Nonstatutory provisions.

(1r) RECONCILIATION PROVISION. The amendment of section 947.0125 (2m) of
the statutes, as created by this act, and 948.115 (2) of the statutes, as created by this
act, and SECTION 4s (lg), (2h) and (3i) of this act are void unless the treatment, of
section 939.50 (1) (i) and (3) (i) of the statutes by 1999 Assembly Bill 465 is enacted
into law before July 1, 2000, in exactly the same form as it appears in sections 237
and 246 of 1999 Assembly Bill 465, as passed by the assembly.

SECTION 4s. Effective dates. This act takes effect on the day after publication,
except as follows:

(lg) If 1999 Assembly Bill 465 has been enacted on or before the day after
publication of this and the day after publication of this and or before
