Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate:

This bill prohibits any person, including public agencies, from disclosing any personal information about or obtained from a person under 18 years of age for commercial or trade purposes without the prior written consent of the parent or guardian of the child. The person given consent to disclose information about the child must provide the parent or guardian certain information, including the information being disclosed and the identity of persons to whom the information will be disclosed.

Costs to local school districts are associated with staff time and resources in providing the additional information to parents or guardians as required by the bill and obtaining written consent. Because it is unknown how many times a school district will disclose information about a person under age 18 for commercial or trade purposes, these costs are indeterminable.

This bill has no fiscal effect on the department of public instruction.
