- 1 AN ACT *to create* 118.135 of the statutes; **relating to:** providing a public school
- for a pupil that is accessible by the pupil's disabled parent.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill provides that, upon the request of a parent or guardian who has a disability that makes it difficult or impossible for the person to gain access to the public school attended by his or her child or ward, the school board must allow the person to choose for the child or ward a public school that is more easily accessible by the person.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 118.135 of the statutes is created to read:
