The bill decreases the department's educational leadership-general program operations appropriation, 20.255 (1) (a),									
by \$111,800 beginning in fiscal year 2000-01. This decrease reflects 1.6 FTE positions funded under this									
appropriation and the elimination of expenditures for services and supplies and educational conferences and projects									
relating to the program that are funded under this appropriation.									
The bill also requires DPI annually to audit a number of school districts to monitor compliance with the requirement to									
provide instruction about American Indian tribes and bands in Wisconsin. DPI would determine the number of districts									
to be audited. The bill requires DPI to annually report the results of the audits to the American Indian study									
committee.									
It is a seed that 4.0 ETE of the power greated 2.0 ETE positions will be filled by the incumbents of those positions									
It is assumed that 1.6 FTE of the newly created 3.0 FTE positions will be filled by the incumbents of those positions, and the department will need to hire an additional 1.4 FTE. Salary and fringe costs to the department to fund the 1.6									
existing and 1.4 new FTE positions total \$161,000 annually. The remaining \$89,000 in the new appropriation will be									
used for supplies and services, permanent property, and other costs associated with curriculum development, school									
district audits, report preparation, and educational conferences and projects.									
There is no local fiscal effect as a result of this bill.
