

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate <p>Current law grants state patrol officers specific powers and duties, including the enforcement of traffic laws. Current law also prohibits a person from possessing or using fireworks without a permit unless certain conditions apply.</p> <p>This bill expands the powers and duties of state patrol officers to include the enforcement of the permit requirement for the possession and use of fireworks where applicable to highways. In exercising this new power and duty, state patrol officers may issue uniform traffic citations for violations of the permit requirement. Demerit points would not be assessed for these violations.</p> <p>The enactment of this bill would not affect state patrol costs, or the enforcement of traffic laws. Some additional training would be required, but this training would be included in training programs that are provided to state patrol officers on an annual basis.</p> <p>If additional citations are issued as a consequence of the enactment of AB 591, local revenues would increase. The amount of the revenue increase cannot be reasonably estimated, but probably would not be significant.</p>
