Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate:

LRB 3411/1 would direct the Wisconsin Higher Educational Aids Board (HEAB) to establish and administer an international baccalaureate diploma grant program. The program would allow high school students, who fulfilled the necessary requirements to earn an international baccalaureate diploma, to be awarded an annual \$250 grant from HEAB and a matching grant from a participating college or university in Wisconsin if certain criteria are met.

In order to establish and administer this program, a Grant Specialist (program coordinator) and 25% of a Comprehensive Professional (computer systems specialist) would need to be funded.

Costs associated with funding 1.25 positions are as follows:

Grant Specialist	\$36,391
Comprehensive Professional (25%)	\$12,233
Total costs	\$48,624
