## ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 596

January 26, 2000 – Offered by Representative PETROWSKI.

AN ACT *to renumber and amend* 23.16 (3) and 23.165 (4); and *to create* 23.16 (3) (b), 23.165 (4) (b) and 23.45 of the statutes; **relating to:** the disclosure of personal identifiers obtained by the department of natural resources from fish and game approval applications, campsite reservation applications, certain registration applications, applications for certificates of number for boats and subscription requests.

## *The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

7 SECTION 1. 23.16 (3) of the statutes is renumbered 23.16 (3) (intro.) and
8 amended to read:

9 23.16 (3) SUBSCRIBER LISTS. (intro.) The department may refuse to reveal
 10 names and addresses of persons on any magazine or periodical subscriber list. The
 11 department may not reveal names and addresses of persons as prohibited under s.
 12 23.45 (5). The department may charge a fee to recover the actual costs for providing

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1	or for the use of any magazine or periodical subscriber list. No person who obtains
2	or uses any magazine or periodical subscriber list from the department may refer to
3	the department, the magazine or the periodical as the source of names or addresses
4	unless the person clearly <del>indicates</del> <u>states</u> that the provision of <u></u> , or permission to use <u>,</u>
5	the subscriber list in no way indicates the <u>any of the following:</u>
6	(a) The department's knowledge, involvement, approval, authorization or
7	connection with the person or the person's activities.

11	SECTION 3. 23.165 (4) of the statutes is renumbered 23.165 (4) (intro.) and

13	23.165 (4) SUBSCRIBER LISTS. (intro.) Notwithstanding s. 19.35, the The
14	department may refuse to reveal names and addresses of persons on any publication
15	subscriber list. <u>The department may not reveal names and addresses as prohibited</u>
16	under s. 23.45 (5). The department may charge a fee to recover the actual costs for
17	providing or for the use of a publication subscriber list. No person who obtains or uses
18	a publication subscriber list from the department may refer to the department or the
19	publication as the source of names or addresses unless the person clearly indicates
20	states that the provision of, or permission to use, the subscriber list in no way
21	indicates the <u>any of the following:</u>
22	(a) The department's knowledge, involvement, approval, authorization or

23 connection with the person or the person's activities.

**SECTION 4.** 23.165 (4) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

3	<b>SECTION 5.</b> 23.45 of the statutes is created to read:
4	<b>23.45 Nondisclosure of certain personal information. (1)</b> In this section:
5	(a) "Approval" has the meaning given in s. 29.001 (12).
6	(b) "Campsite" means a campsite in a state campground established and
7	operated by the department.
8	(c) "List" means information compiled or maintained by the department that
9	contains the personal identifiers of 10 or more individuals.
10	(d) "Personal identifier" means a name, street address, post-office box number
11	or telephone number.
12	(e) "Privilege" means an approval, a campsite reservation, a certificate of
13	number under s. 30.52 (5) (a) or a registration.
14	(f) "Registration" means an all-terrain vehicle registration under s. 23.33 (2),
15	a boat registration under s. 30.52 (5) (b) or a snowmobile registration under s. 350.12
16	(3).
17	(g) "State agency" has the meaning given in s. 20.001 (1).
18	(h) "Subscription" means an agreement to receive, on a periodic basis, a
19	magazine, periodical or publication that is produced by the department.
20	(2) If a form that the department requires an individual to complete in order
21	to receive a privilege or subscription requires the individual to provide any of the
22	individual's personal identifiers, the form shall include all of the following:
23	(a) A place for the individual to declare that the individual's personal
24	identifiers obtained by the department from an application to receive a privilege or
25	from a subscription request may not be disclosed on any list.

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1 (b) A statement indicating the effect of declaring that the individual's personal 2 identifiers obtained by the department from an application to receive a privilege or 3 from a subscription request may not be disclosed on any list.

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(c) A place for the individual to reverse a declaration that the individual's 5 personal identifiers obtained by the department from an application to receive a privilege or from a subscription request may not be disclosed on any list. 6

7 (3) If the department requires an individual to provide, by telephone or other 8 electronic means, any of the person's personal identifiers in order to receive a 9 privilege or subscription, the department shall do all of the following at the time that 10 the individual provides a personal identifier to the department:

11 (a) Ask the individual if the individual wants to declare that the individual's 12 personal identifiers obtained by the department from an application to receive a 13 privilege or from a subscription request may not be disclosed on any list.

14 (b) Advise the individual of the effect of declaring that the individual's personal 15 identifiers obtained by the department from an application to receive a privilege or 16 from a subscription request may not be disclosed on any list.

17 (c) Ask the individual if the individual wants to reverse a declaration that the 18 individual's personal identifiers obtained by the department from an application to 19 receive a privilege or from a subscription request may not be disclosed on any list.

20 (4) Upon the request of an individual who has applied for a privilege from the 21 department or has requested a subscription from the department, the department 22 shall provide a form to the individual that includes all of the following:

23 A place for the individual to declare that the individual's personal (a) 24 identifiers obtained by the department from an application to receive a privilege or 25 from a subscription request may not be disclosed on any list.

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1 (b) A statement indicating the effect of declaring that the individual's personal 2 identifiers obtained by the department from an application to receive a privilege or 3 from a subscription request may not be disclosed on any list. 4 (c) A place for the individual to reverse a declaration made under this 5 subsection or sub. (2) or (3) that the individual's personal identifiers obtained by the 6 department from an application to receive a privilege or from a subscription request 7 may not be disclosed on any list. 8 (5) (a) The department may not disclose on any list that it furnishes to another 9 person a personal identifier of any individual who has made a declaration under sub. 10 (2), (3) or (4), except as provided in par. (b). If the department receives conflicting 11 declarations from an individual under sub. (2), (3) or (4), the department shall give 12 effect to the individual's most recent declaration. (b) Paragraph (a) does not apply to a list that the department furnishes to 13 14 another state agency. A state agency that receives a list from the department 15 containing a personal identifier of any person who has made a declaration under sub.

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## **SECTION 6. Initial applicability.**

(1) The treatment of section 23.45 (5) of the statutes first applies to lists
furnished by the department of natural resources on the effective date of this
subsection.

(2), (3) or (4) may not disclose the list to any person other than a state agency.

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## **SECTION 7. Effective date.**

(1) This act takes effect on the first day of the 6th month beginning afterpublication.

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
