AN ACT relating to: observing[✓] James Madison's birthday.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law requires schools to observe certain days, such as the birthday of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.[✓] The bill requires schools to observe the birthday of James Madison, on March 16.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 118.02^{✓X} of the statutes is amended to read:

118.02 Special observance days. On the following days when school is held

the day shall be appropriately observed: January 15, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.

Day; February 12; February 15, Susan B. Anthony's birthday; February 22; March

6

4, Casimir Pulaski Day; March 16, James Madison's birthday[✓]; April 13, American

7

Creed Day; April 22, Environmental Awareness Day; September 16, Mildred Fish

Harnack Day; September 17, U.S. Constitution Day; September 28, Frances Willard

9

Day; October 9, Leif Erikson Day; October 12; November 11; and Wednesday of the

1 3rd week in September, as part of Wonderful Wisconsin Week under s. 14.16 (8),
2 Wisconsin Day. If any such day falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the observance shall
3 be on a school day immediately preceding or following. If school is held on June 14,
4 that day shall be appropriately observed as Robert M. La Follette, Sr. Day. If the
5 governor by proclamation sets apart one day to be designated as Arbor and Bird Day,
6 under s. 14.16 (l), that day shall be appropriately observed; otherwise, the last
7 Friday in April shall be observed as Arbor Day.
