
Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate:

This bill repeals the requirement that applicants for various professional, business, and occupational licenses, and applicants for vehicle titles, provide their social security numbers. The bill also repeals the requirement for an agency to deny licensing to an applicant if no social security number is given. The bill continues the requirement that a federal employee identification number (FEIN) be submitted, for a non-individual applicant for various licenses.

This bill has no fiscal impact on the Department of Transportation or the Transportation Fund.
