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Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill eliminates the requirement in current law that applicants for licenses, permits and other credentials include their social security number on their application. It also eliminates the requirement that social security numbers be included on certain documents related to marriage and children and in records relating to death and repeals the requirement that the licensing authority must deny or suspend an application or revoke or suspend an approval if a person fails to provide the number. This provision, if enacted, would put DWD out of compliance with the requirements of the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996 (P.L. 104-93) and the Balanced Budget Act of 1997 (P.L. 105-33) which require states to have procedures for the collection of social security numbers on applications for licenses. This, in turn, would subject the state of Wisconsin to potential loss of federal funding the state receives for W-2 and the child support program. Wisconsin currently receives \$60 million annually in child support funding and \$318 million annually in TANF funding, all of which would be at risk.

Additionally, the state's ability to enforce child support orders through the use of license suspension would be inhibited, thereby potentially reducing child support collections.
