Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate:		
AB 626 would prohibit the use of general purpose revenue or program revenue, other than from gifts, for costs associated with sending family members and friends of faculty and staff and nonessential personnel to conferences, competitions, seminars and other events. The effect of the bill on UW System would be minimal. In general, UW System travel regulations already prohibit reimbursement for expenses that are not UW-business related. The regulations also specifically prohibit reimbursement for family members' travel costs, except for certain circumstances in which costs for a spouse of a Chancellor or the President may be reimbursable. These circumstances apply only if the spouse is required to appear as an official representative of the UW. Reimbursement is made upon the submittal of a brochure specifying a business related spouse program and a statement describing the official capacity in which the spouse was acting and the reason the spouse was required to attend.		
There are also rare instances in which the UW System receives grant funds in which it is either directed or allowed to reimburse for certain expenses that would be affected under the bill.
