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### **Describe the problem to be corrected by the legislation.**

The current composition of the Controlled Substances Board is the attorney general, the secretary of health and family services and the secretary of agriculture, trade and consumer protection, or their designees; the chairperson of the pharmacy examining board or a designee; and one psychiatrist and one pharmacologist appointed for 3-year terms. Sec. 15.405(5g), Stats. The current composition does not provide for representation from the Board of Nursing and Medical Examining Board. These two boards enforce laws relating to prescribing and deli very of controlled substances and should have 'input into decisions of the Controlled Substances Board.

### **How should the problem be corrected?**

Add a member of designee from the Board of Nursing and Medical Examining Board to the membership of the Controlled Substances Board

### **Has this proposal been introduced as legislation before? If so, when and under what bill numb?**

Not introduced as legislation

### **What is the likely fiscal effect of the proposal?**

Additional costs of \$2,063 annually are required to pay for the per diems and travel expenses for the boards six annual meetings. (See budget proposal for basis of estimate.)

# 1999 BILL

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1 AN ACT . . . . relating to: membership of the controlled substances board.

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

Under current law, the controlled substances board consists of one psychiatrist, one pharmacologist and the following persons or their designees: the attorney general; the secretary of health and family services. the secretary of agriculture, trade and consumer protection and the chairperson of the pharmacy examining board. Under this bill, the chairpersons of the board of nursing and the medical examining board, or their designees, are also members of the board.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

2 SECTION 1. 15.405 (5g) <sup>X</sup> of the statutes is amended to read:
