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Under current law, a portion of that payment is attributable to exempt ATMs. As noted, exempt ATMs are valued at about \$45.5 million or 0.18% (\$45.5 mil./\$2,550 mil.) of the total value of exempt computer property. Under the bill, the state would not pay aids on ATMs so the computer aid payment would decline by 0.18% or by \$1.2 million (0.18% x \$64.5 mil.).

Assuming computer aid payments attributable to exempt ATMs are exactly equal to the property taxes that would be levied on ATMs, were they taxable, the bill would have no fiscal effect on local units of government.
