

1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 656

January 19, 2000 – Introduced by Representatives WALKER, WARD, STONE, DUFF, SYKORA, M. LEHMAN, ALBERS, STASKUNAS and PLALE, cosponsored by Senators BURKE, DARLING, ROSENZWEIG, PANZER and GEORGE. Referred to Joint survey committee on Retirement Systems.

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 20.515 (1) (bm) and 40.02 (17) (gr) of the statutes; **relating to:**
2 granting creditable service under the Wisconsin retirement system to certain
3 assistant district attorneys formerly employed by Milwaukee County and
4 making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill grants creditable service under the Wisconsin retirement system (WRS) to former assistant district attorneys who were employed in the Milwaukee County district attorney's office on December 31, 1989, who became state employees and WRS participants on January 1, 1990, who were not vested in the Milwaukee County employees' retirement system (MCERS) at the time of their becoming participants in the WRS and who terminated state employment before October 29, 1999, for their total period of service under the MCERS.

This bill will be referred to the joint survey committee on retirement systems for a detailed analysis, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.
