Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate:

AB 656 grants creditable service under the WRS to former assistant district attorneys who were employed in the Milwaukee County district attorney's office on 12/31/89, who became state employees and WRS participants on 1/1/90, who were not vested in the Milwaukee County employees' retirement system (MCERS) and who terminated state employment before 10/29/99.

The costs of granting the creditable service will be paid out of a GPR sum sufficient appropriation. There are 19 former assistant district attorneys affected by the bill. The cost of granting the additional service is \$440,200 GPR.
