SUBJECT: Draft Amendment to 1999 Assembly Bill 661

Attached to this memorandum is a copy of **WLCS: 0242/1**, an amendment to 1999 Assembly Bill 661. Assembly Bill 661 relates to using night vision equipment while hunting or possessing a weapon. The amendment makes the following two changes to the bill:

- The definition of “night vision equipment” is expanded to include technology that converts ambient *heat* into an electronic image. Currently, the bill only refers to technology that converts ambient light into an electronic image. This change expands the bill to include infrared technology.
- The prohibition in the bill on possessing or using night vision equipment, for which a criminal penalty is provided, is narrowed to include only use of this equipment for locating deer or bear. Currently, the bill applies this prohibition to all wild animals. The bill continues to apply the civil penalty to the use of night vision equipment for locating or attempting to locate wild animals.

If this memorandum meets your needs, it should be submitted to the Legislative Reference Bureau for drafting. If I can provide further information on this subject, please feel free to contact me.
