Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate This bill makes various changes to the laws regarding the information that a person must provide to a firearms dealer when purchasing a handgun. One such change includes increasing the penalty for a person who intentionally provides false information on the notification form. Specifically, the penalty is increased from not more than nine months in jail (a misdemeanor) to five years in prison (a felony). Changing a crime from a misdemeanor to a felony would increase costs to the State Public Defender's Office (SPD) because felony cases are more expensive than misdemeanor cases. The SPD cannot estimate the extent of those costs, however, because it is unknown how many such cases the agency would handle if this bill is passed.							
Long-Range Fiscal Implications Indeterminate at this time. Agency will monitor fiscal effect of this bill, if enacted, for future budget considerations.
