Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law requires health insurance policies, including managed care plans, to provide coverage ofvarious health care services and medical procedures, including mammograms, breast reconstruction incident to mastectomy, lead poisoning screening for children and treatment for the correction of 'temporomandibular disorders. This bill requires managed care plans, which are health care plans that provide incentives for enrollees to obtain health care services from providers that are managed, owned, under contract with or employed by the plans, to provide coverage of health care costs incurred in connection with clinical trial programs for the treatment of children's cancer. Coverage is required for a person enrolled in such a clinical trial program if the clinical trial program is approved by the federal food and drug administration, the person has coverage under the plan, the person was diagnosed with a childhood cancer before the age of 19 years and the person is not eligible for any other benefits that would pay the costs of the program. The coverage may be subject to any limitations, exclusions or cost-sharing provisions that apply generally under the plan.
