1 **AN ACT relating to:** ratification of the agreement negotiated between the state  
2 of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin State Building Trades Negotiating Committee,  
3 AFL-CIO, and its appropriate affiliated locals, for the 1999-01 biennium,  
4 covering employes in the building trades crafts collective bargaining unit, and  
5 authorizing an expenditure of funds.

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

This proposal is introduced under section 111.92 (1) of the statutes.' The proposal ratifies the collective bargaining contract for state employes in the building trades crafts collective bargaining unit negotiated for the 1999-01 biennium under the state employment labor relations act. Currently, statutory program supplement appropriations fund the costs of collective bargaining agreements to the extent that they exceed budgeted costs. The proposal authorizes expenditure of moneys from those appropriations to fund the cost of this agreement.
